Location

The Latitude and Longitude of Libya are 29.9569 degrees North and 15.7461 degrees East

A Major Need in Libya!



Government

The government is a Military Dictatorship. As a result of the collapse of the Gaddafi government in August 2011, due to the Libyan civil war, Libya is under de facto administration of the National Transitional Council. The NTC pledged to organize democratic elections by April 2012, and expects Libya to develop into a constitutional democracy by 2013.

Transportation

In Libya the transportation there is a lot like our transportation here. They use buses, cars, bikes, and of course you can walk. But unlike here in America, not all of the highways and airport runways in Libya are paved, since there is a lack of money in Libya and there ia a lack of pavement and concrete.

Elections

In July 2012, Muslim voted in it's first national election since Col. Muammar Qaddafi was ousted. And the turnout was over 60 percent. On Sept. 11, 2012, armed gunmen attacked the American consulate in Benghazi and killed U.S. ambassador Christopher Stevens, and three other embassy officials.
